This new issue opens the tenth volume of JIDM. It brings four articles, one article regularly submitted to the Journal (Regular Papers Section) and three extended versions of best papers from the XIX Brazilian Symposium on GeoInformatics – GEOINFO 2018. GEOINFO was held in Campina Grande, Brazil, from December 5^{th} to December 7^{th} , 2018.

The article presented in Regular papers Section, entitled Inout Secure DB: Maximizing security for data INside and OUTside the database, is authored by Luiz Gomes-Jr, Isabella Mika Taninaka, Marcelo Rosa, Keiko Fonseca and Daniel Lucani. It address the problem the security in the database system that takes privacy for cloud services.

Section GEOINFO 2018 includes extended and revised versions of papers selected from GEOINFO 2018. Lbia Vinhas, from the Brazilian National Institute for Space Research (INPE) was the Program Chair. Both chairs selected the candidate papers for this edition. The three articles included in this edition are examples of research partnership, including 15 researchers from Brazilian institutions (UNB, UFG, UTFPR, UFSCAR, USP) and foreign universities (University of Thessaly, Greece and University of Almeria, Spain). Research areas include machine learning, remote sensing, time series analysis, and spatial databases.
